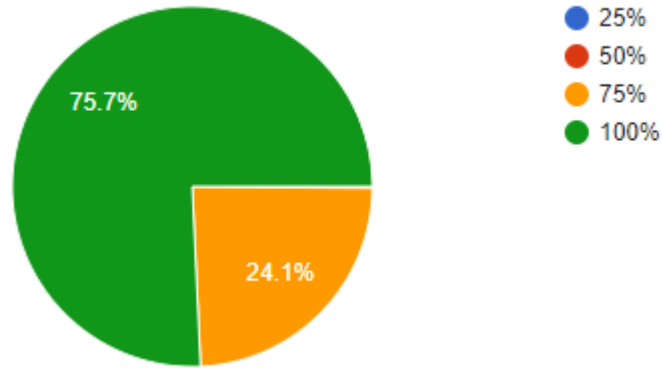
Survey conducted on 6th January 2020 by using following questionnaire and totally 680 students participated and completed within the time limit and the analysis report is explained in below table.
